❖ **Library**

The library is a growing organism. This element was Presented by Dr. S. R. Ranganathan. The college library has completed 31 years. Initially there were 350 books. Today books reached to 27,400. Apart from this, donation books have also been received from various donors and organizations. Many dignitaries have visited this year. In the year 2014 - 2015, a total of Rs. 6,56,762/- has been spent and the number of books has increased by 1,533.

➤ **Periodical / Journal Section**

In the year 2014 - 2015, the library includes various subjects and subject wise journals as well as periodicals required for competitive examinations. The total number of periodicals available in the library is 71.

➤ **Newspaper Section**

The library has a total of 11 newspapers in English, Hindi and Marathi languages at national and local level. Approximately, Rs. 12,000 / - has been spent on it.

➤ **Library Services:**

The college central library provides following services:

1. Issue- Return Section: An average of 225 to 250 books are issued and submitted daily to the readers from the library.

2. Reference service: Library provides references to readers with an average of 30 to 35 references daily.

3. Periodical Service: Magazines, Journals and newspapers are continuously served to the readers in an open access.

4. Newspaper cuttings service: News on various issues / subjects and current events are provided to the students by newspaper clippings on notice board.

5. Inter-Library Service: Under inter-library service our college makes books available to readers which are not available in our library from other college which having it. At other side we also issue books to other college.

6. Study Room: There is a separate study room for students and staff members and 125 readers can sit in the study room at a time. From Monday to Saturday the study room opens at 8 am and closed at 5.30 am. Study room time is extended as per the demand of the readers during the examination period.

7. Computerization: The work of computerization and digitization of the library is going on regularly in the library.

8. Battery Facility in Case of Electricity Load Shedding: Battery facility has been provided in case the power supply was abandoned by electricity load shedding in the library.

9. Firefighting: Firefighting equipment and training required for accident prevention are available in the library.

10. Book Classification: The books in the library are classified according to the subject in Dewey Decimal Classification method.

11. Bibliography: Bibliography service is available in the library according to the subject of the bibliography.

12. Book stock checking: Library stock checking was done every year.

13. Orientation Program: Librarian and library staff provide information to the students, teachers and other readers through coordination through demonstrations. Newly admitted students are also informed about the working of the library by orientation program.

14. Suggestion Box: A suggestion box has been set up at the entrance of the library for the notice of all.

15. Staff Education and Motivation: Library staff are always encouraged for higher education. Library also gives training to library staff of new technology, development in library.
